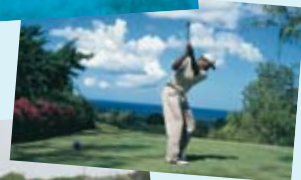
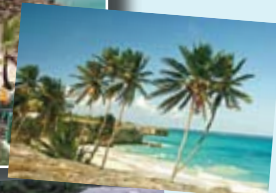


## YOUR BASE IN BARBADOS:
